page 99: line 4 up from the bottom - "prepositional phrases" should be replaced by "spatial expressions"
page 105: line 5 in (4.19) - man $^{*} \cap \mathbf{r u n}^{*}=\emptyset$
page 119: fonts for " $\mathrm{VP}_{1}$ " and " $\mathrm{VP}_{2}$ " should be roman
page 133: line 5 of exercise 7 a - the second occurrence of "AND ${ }^{e t}$ " should be "OR ${ }^{e t "}$
page 157: the sentence below (5.42) should be: "In words: there is a teacher $u$ such that Tina believes that Mary praised $u$, and $u$ smiled."
page 167: line 3 of second paragraph should end with "no pretensions to"
page 180: the sentence starting on line 14 should be: "By contrast, the different orders in which the subject and object signs are combined with the verb may affect the truth-value that is derived for sentence (5.60a)."
page 228, exercise 4: in the definition of the properties for teacher, smile and chinese, the indices $w_{1}, w_{2}, w_{3}$ and $w_{4}$ should appear in superscript, rather than as direct arguments of the function.
For instance, " $\left(\operatorname{teacher}\left(w_{1}\right)\right)^{* "}$ should be " $\left(\operatorname{teacher}^{w_{1}}\right)^{* "}$, i.e. the set of entities $\left\{x \in D_{e}:\right.$ teacher $\left.(x)\left(w_{1}\right)=1\right\}$.

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
